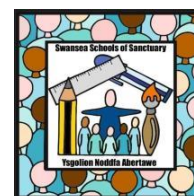

On Wednesday 7th May, we would like the children to dress up as a Victorian child for the day – there will be more information on Class Dojo about this.

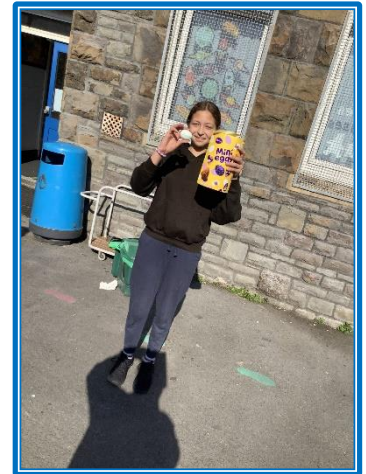
On Thursday 8th May, we are having a special assembly to share the history of the school.
